Wednesday, July 1, 2026

The Void - 213 Sixth St - Officers were dispatched in reference to a fight. Officer is conducting follow up in reference to the incident. A license premise report will be completed. **26-033386**

The Foxhole Lounge - 820 Main St - Officers were dispatched in reference to a civil trouble. Parties were separated and a license premise report was completed. No violations observed. **26-033518**

Saturday, July 4, 2026

Sleepy's Lounge - 1641 Douglas Ave - Officers were dispatched in reference to an assault report that occurred inside the bar. Suspect left prior to police arrival. A license premise report was completed and bartender on scene did not have a physical copy of the operators license. The tavern was closed for the night. **26-033966**
