Please be informed that the Public Safety and Licensing Committee of the Common Council of the City of Racine will meet at 5:00 P.M., on Wednesday, July 15, 2026 in room 303, City Hall, pursuant to a formal expression of concern issued against you as it relates to the licensed premises located at 1111 Washington Ave, Racine, WI, 53403, under section 6-27 of the City of Racine Code of Ordinances. Specifically, the relevant issues include but are not limited to the following incidents:

**05/02/2026 – Select 627 – 1111 Washington Ave** - Officers self dispatched to conduct a license premise check. Officers observed multiple people entering and leaving the establishment. As officers attempted contact, the door was closed and they were refused entry. Officers observed approximately 60 people inside the bar. Officers made entry through the back door as patrons were leaving. The bar was empty and they located a party hiding in the closet which was arrested on warrants. They spoke to the male who advised the bartender had left and that he was the husband of the owner. Party was cited and arrested. 26-021619

**05/29/2026 – Select 627 – 1111 Washington Ave** - Officers were dispatched in reference to a fight. Parties were identified and then released. Officers attempted to conduct a license premise check and the lights were shut off and door was closed. Officers then knocked and eventually made contact with a bartender. It should be noted 12 patrons were still inside as officers made entry. Bartender did not have a valid operators license and was issued a citation. The bartender was the only one on scene and advised the owner left an hour prior to police arriving. Owner was also issued a citation. **26-026758**

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Sec. 6-27. - Actions by the committee.

(a) Formal expression of concern. (1) The public safety and licensing committee may require the appearance of any licensee before the committee at any time to address issues related to the licensed premises through a written formal expression of concern, sent via first class mail to the licensee. (2) If the licensee fails to appear for the formal expression of concern, the committee may refer the matter to the city attorney's office for consideration of further disciplinary action. (3) If the licensee appears for the formal expression of concern, no discussion of the alleged facts may be permitted unless the licensee requests such discussion and only after the licensee has been advised that any statements made by him or her and/or his or her representatives regarding the alleged underlying facts may be considered by the due process board in any subsequent suspension/revocation hearing which may result from the alleged violations which are the subject of the formal expression of concern. (b) Referral for disciplinary proceedings. (1) Any licensee who has been issued two formal expressions of concern within a six month period, or three or more formal expressions of concern within a one year period, shall be referred to the city attorney's office for consideration of further disciplinary proceedings as contemplated under section 6-26 of this Code. For purposes of this section, the date the committee votes to issue a formal expression of concern shall be the date used to calculate any time period prescribed. (2) Nothing in this section shall be construed to conflict with, abridge or modify, the rights or procedures established for revocation or suspension of licenses in Wis. Stats. § 125.12 provided there is cause for disciplinary proceedings under the relevant ordinances or statutes.
