SUBJECT: Communication sponsored by Alder Horton, on behalf of the Transit & Mobility Director, requesting authorization for the Mayor and City Clerk to accept the Urban Mass Transit Assistance - Operating 2026 Program Grant Agreement between FTA and the City of Racine (Grant Control #00672).

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) has awarded the City of Racine funding through the Urban Mass Transit Assistance – Operating 2026 Program under the Section 5307 Formula Grant Program. These federal funds are intended to support the operation of the City’s public transit services and assist in maintaining reliable transportation options for residents and visitors. The City of Racine has been allocated \$4,173,665 in federal operating assistance for 2026, as determined by the FTA Section 5307 Formula Program. Acceptance of this grant agreement will allow the City to utilize these funds for eligible transit operating expenses in accordance with federal requirements.

BUDGETARY IMPACT:

Grant amount of \$4,173,665 as determined by FTA 5307 Formula, local share approved in 2026 operating budget.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and directed to accept the Urban Mass Transit Assistance - Operating 2026 Program Grant Agreement between FTA and the City of Racine.
