Date	Meeting	Purpose	Outcome
June 2026	Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Center / Clinic	Construction of the New Building / Facility in the Lincoln King Neighborhood	Monthly site visits and weekly discussions continue with City consultants/contractors to review project parameters, including information technology, equipment, furniture, and construction progress. The current goal is to have the building operational by mid-October.
June 2026	Semi-Quincentennial Planning	Determine Festivities	Continued planning and discussion on how to recognize and celebrate the Nation's 250-year anniversary.
June 2026	2027 Budget	Budget Initiation	Budget calendar and the first round of administrative materials have been received which include proposed fee schedule, program narratives, and goals.
June 2026	Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan Revision	Meeting Number Two	City Transit has taken the lead on this project with the assistance of SEWRPC. Discussions on what was accomplished, the viability of some of the recommendations, responsibility, and potential implementation of recommendations.
June 2026	Potential Relocation of the PHD Laboratory Division	Request From City Administration	Third meeting was held with Water, Wastewater, and Parks Departments. Discussed materials included: <i>Appendix C: Regulatory Consultation; IDEXX Tecta: Evaluation, and Laboratory Analysis; and External Contracting Cost Assessment documents</i> . Further information such as timeline, budget, and expectations will be discussed with City Administration. The PHD has had a Laboratory Division since the 1930's.
