Lighthouse Run

Resolved, that permission is granted to 5Kevents.org, LLC to use certain City streets for a period time of 8:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 20, 2026, per the following conditions:

PARTIAL CLOSURES

One lane of traffic may be temporarily closed on the following streets:

5k will cone the parking lane and install the “No parking signs” where needed North Bound Lane on Main Street bridge between 1st street and Dodge Street. Dodge Street – parking lane east bound will be coned.

Reichert Court - coned

Michigan Boulevard – North bound lane from Augusta Street to Lakecrest Avenue coned.

Further recommends that the Commissioner of Public Works be authorized and directed to communicate with the U.S. Coast Guard requesting permission to close Main Street Bridge to boat traffic for a period of 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 20, 2026, to satisfy the needs of this run.

Further recommends that this permission is granted with the following stipulations:

- A. A hold harmless agreement be executed and a \$75.00 processing fee paid.
- B. A liability insurance certificate be filed prior to this event.
- C. Any overtime costs incurred by any City department be charged to the sponsor.
- D. The sponsor shall notify all abutting property owners 72 hours in advance of this event.
- E. The sponsor shall pay a \$1325.00 special event fee.
- F. Sponsor shall be responsible for submitting a Temporary Traffic Control Plan to the Engineering Department for approval and providing and removing all temporary traffic control devices and detour signs.

G. Sponsor shall provide a detour plan for the closure of all State connecting highways, arterial and collector streets to the City Engineer for approval.

H. Sponsor is responsible for cleaning the streets.

I. Sponsor shall install parking meter hoods or temporary parking signs at least 24 hours in advance of the event and if this is not done, sponsor is responsible for vehicle towing and parking violation expenses of the violators.

Further recommends that the Commissioner of Public Works and City Engineer provide limited assistance, in the interest of public safety, to implement this event.

Fiscal Note: There will be nominal costs to various City Departments, on a regular basis, to assist in implementing this event.
