Fourth of July Parade on July 4, 2026

Resolved, that the Public Works and Services having found that the standards for parade permit issuance set forth in Racine Ordinances section 82-39(f) have been met, permission is granted to the Downtown Racine Corporation to close the streets below, subject to the conditions set forth in Racine Ordinances section 82-39(g).

Main Street from Shoreland Avenue to Fourteenth Street,
Fourteenth Street from the lake to Racine Street,
Michigan Boulevard for pre-parade staging from Goold Street to St. Patrick's Street,
Ruby Avenue from South Street to Shoreland Avenue,
Walton Avenue, Romayne Avenue, Augusta Street, Wolff Street, William Street, Isabelle Avenue, and Melvin Avenue between Main Street and Erie Street.

Further recommends that the Commissioner of Public Works be authorized and directed to communicate with the U.S. Coast Guard requesting permission to close the Main Street and State Street bridges to masted boat traffic for the period from 7:45 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and from 9:30 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. on July 4, 2026.

Further recommends that the Commissioner of Public Works, City Engineer, and Chief of Police provide limited assistance, in the interest of public safety, to implement this event.

Fiscal Note: Parade organizer shall pay the Permit Fee set forth in Racine Ordinances section 82-39(f) and comply with the conditions set forth in Racine Ordinances section 82-39(g).
