Re: Final Resolution for Paving Assessable Alleys.

A public hearing was held on Tuesday 4/28/26 for Street improvements. A determination of the percentage of property frontage in support of or against the following individual street improvements will be made available on Monday 5/11/2026 for consideration by the 5/26/2026 Public Works & Services committee (PW&SC):

- Barbara Drive – Cul-de-sac to Golf Ave. / Weidner
- Biscayne Avenue – Oakwood Dr. to Monarch Dr. / Harmon
- Crabapple Drive – Hickory Way to Cul-de-sac / Allen
- Debra Lane – Delaware Ave. to Winthrop Ave. / Peete
- Howland Avenue - Roe Ave. to West 6th Street / Davis
- Indiana Street - Durand Ave. to Pierce Boulevard / Harmon
- Kings Circle - Cul-de-sac to Oakwood Dr. / Harmon
- Lombard Avenue – North Main St. to Chatham St. / Jorgensen
- Monarch Drive – Emstan Hills Rd to Regal Ct. / Harmon
- N. Wisconsin Street - Cul-de-sac to Carlton Dr. / Pabon
- Reichert Court – Michigan Blvd. to Dead End / Frazier

The PW&SC will consider each street separately based on data presented and then recommend action on the preliminary resolution to the Common Council on 6/2/26.

Fiscal Note: These are assessable city projects; all costs will be paid by the abutting property owners.
